

# TRIVIA

## Night

### RULES

1. Relax and have FUN! Teams are encouraged to come up with a creative name and dress in costumes for the event.
2. Each team will consist of four members, including a Captain who is the designated responder.
3. There will be three trivia rounds. The first round will last 20 minutes and will include 10 trivia questions from a variety of categories, followed by a 10-minute intermission, the second round will also last 20 minutes and will include 10 trivia questions followed by a 10-minute intermission and the final round will have harder trivia questions and end when only one team remains.
4. The announcer will read the trivia question a minimum of 2 times, some trivia questions might include visual or audio guides. Teams will have 30 seconds to collaborate on the answer and clearly write their team answer on the white board that will be provided.
5. Once time is up, the teams will all hold up their answer. The announcer will provide the correct answer.
6. Judges will be placed throughout the room to verify answers; teams must show their answer to the nearest judge for verification.
7. Each team will have 3 helium balloons at their table. Once they miss a question, one of their balloons will be popped. If no team gets the question right, then no balloons will be popped that round. During the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> rounds, teams will be able to purchase additional balloons for \$10 each. A team may never have more than 3 balloons. Each team will have the opportunity to enter the round with 3 balloons. However, in the final round, no additional balloons can be purchased.
8. Surprise rounds can happen at any time – such as right answers get a “save my balloon card”
9. The last team with a balloon left will win. In the event of a tie, a tie breaker question will be given.
10. Awards will be presented to first, second and third place teams.
11. Cheating will result in disqualification. Only the 4 team members can help answer the questions. Outside help including electronic assistance is NOT allowed.
12. Team fee of \$100 pays for all team members.
